

# History and Current Impact of OSLN

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## History

**2006** – Battelle started **Metro Early College High School**, Ohio's first STEM School, in partnership with The Ohio State University and the Ohio Business Roundtable.

**2008** – State of Ohio allocated \$13 million in Race to the Top funds to expand STEM schools and hubs in Ohio.

**2010** – Ohio model informed the creation of the Tennessee STEM Innovation Network

**2014** – OSLN named the technical assistance provider to the Ohio STEM Committee

**2022** – Ohio STEM Learning Network receives \$1.5 million annual budget allocation

**2024** – 80+ designated STEM/STEAM schools in Ohio

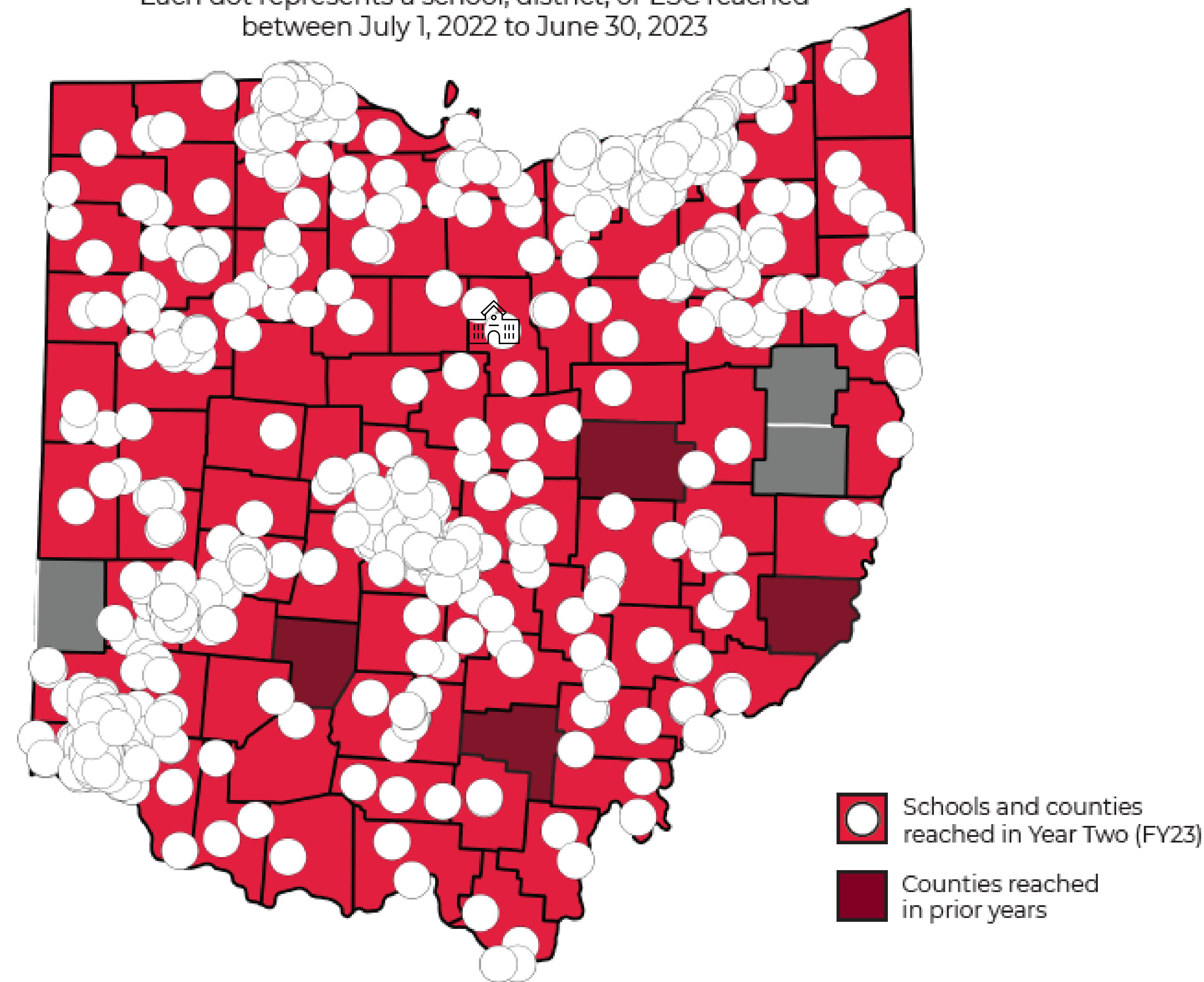

1,468 educators

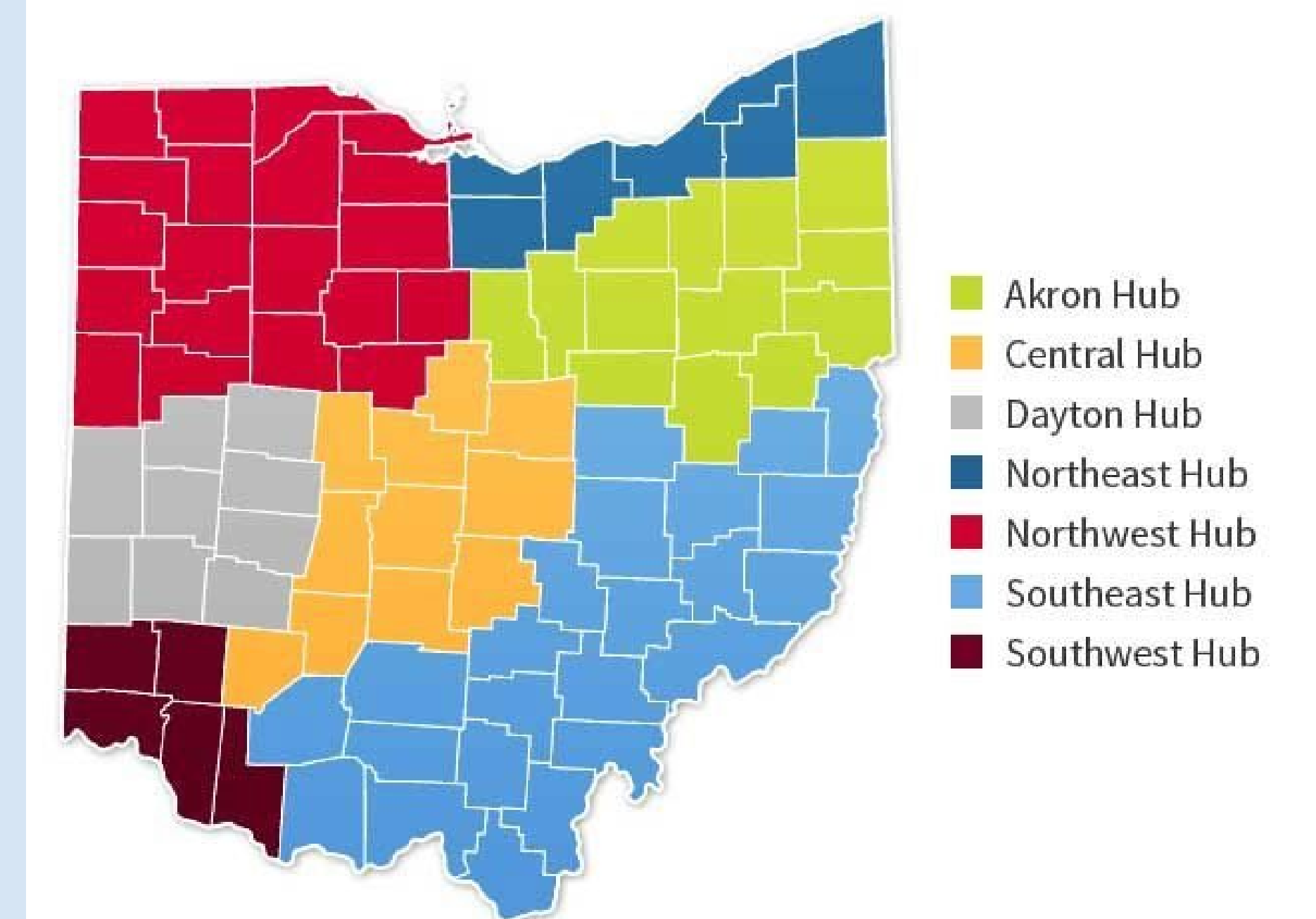
