History

2006 – Battelle started Metro Early College High School, Ohio's first STEM School, in partnership with The Ohio State University and the Ohio Business Roundtable.

2008 – State of Ohio allocated \$13 million in Race to the Top funds to expand STEM schools and hubs in Ohio.

2010 – Ohio model informed the creation of the Tennessee STEM Innovation Network

2014 – OSLN named the technical assistance provider to the Ohio STEM Committee

2022 – Ohio STEM Learning Network receives \$1.5 million annual budget allocation

2024 – 80+ designated STEM/STEAM schools in Ohio







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

FY23 OSLN Reach




